## 2010 Haysville Fall Festival Parade Rules

1. The parade will start at 9:00 a.m. sharp.
2. Check-In will begin at 8:00 a.m. on October 16, 2010 at the Landmark Baptist Church, parade positions will be assigned at that time.
3. You must go in the order you are assigned.
4. **ALL MOTORIZED VEHICLES MUST BE DRIVEN BY A LICENSED DRIVER AND BE OVER 18 YEARS OF AGE.**
5. Any float or vehicle carrying children must have adult supervision. There should be enough adults on board to insure the safety of the group.
6. All motorized vehicles must be driven in a safe manner along the parade route.
7. The parade will start at the Haysville United Methodist Church and end at the west side of the Haysville Middle School.
8. There will be cash prizes for the top three floats First Place= \$150 Second Place= \$100 and Third Place will be \$75. Winners will be announced Saturday at 6:00 p.m.
9. There will be plaques or ribbons given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in the other parade categories.
10. **All adults in the parade should be wearing a Fall Festival Button. Festival Buttons will be on sale at Check-In.**
11. No stopping along the parade route.
12. Use care when throwing candy so that children do not get hurt.
13. Cars that are in the parade and are going to be entered in the car show should go to the park by way of Timberlane Drive.
14. All entries must enter parade formation area by way of Marlen Street through Old Oak Estates. (See attached map)
15. Have a good time.

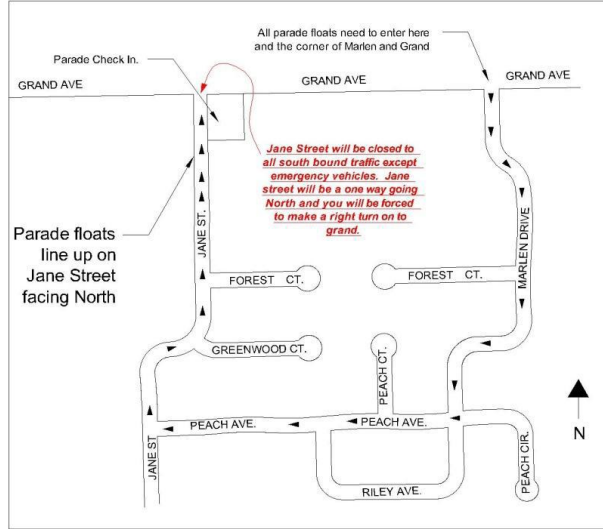
